Dear Pegasus Counselor-in-Training Family,

As Director of Wayland School Community Programs, I am pleased that you are interested in a Counselor-In-Training (CIT) position with the Pegasus Summer Program in 2022. We are planning a fun and enriching summer experience for everyone who participates.

CIT participation in Pegasus is more than simply being another set of hands in the classroom. My goal is for each Pegasus CIT to gain knowledge and skills that will help prepare them for future paid positions as camp counselors, childcare providers, and teachers. To that end, each CIT participates in weekly mentoring sessions that focus on classroom observation, reflection, and feedback, both basic and advanced in nature. These mentoring sessions also include opportunities for CITs to share and learn from each other.

In 2022, Pegasus will run from Monday, June 27 through Friday, August 5, 2022. Session 1 is June 27-July 15 and Session 2 is July 18-August 5. Pegasus will be closed on Monday, July 4, in observance of Independence Day. CITs work from 9:00am-1:00pm, with assignments that immerse them in child-based activities each day. Assignments will be determined by an interview process, CIT preference, and space availability.

CITs can participate for one or both sessions but it is expected that they commit to the entire 3 weeks of whichever session(s) they choose. In 2022, the CIT fees are as follows:

- Session 1 (3 weeks/14 days): \$210
- Session 2 (3 weeks/15 days): \$225
- Both Sessions (6 weeks/29 days): \$400

If Pegasus sounds like a fun way to spend your summer, please complete and return the 2022 CIT application to the address on the form. All CIT applications must be received by Friday, April 8, 2022. Interviews for all applicants will be scheduled in early May. If you have questions or concerns, please feel free to contact me directly. It's going to be a great summer at Pegasus!
